How is Asbestos Toxic to Health?

Besides being an effective insulator, asbestos can strengthen cloth, paper, cement, plastic, and other materials. This hazardous substance is therefore strongly discouraged. Long-term asbestos exposure can lead to the following diseases:

Lung Cancer: Tumors that invade and block the lung's airways are lung cancers. Asbestos exposure and smoking tobacco dramatically increase a person's risk of developing lung cancer.





Asbestosis: By breathing asbestos fibres, asbestosis causes scarring in the lungs. Scarred lungs have more difficulty breathing because oxygen and carbon dioxide cannot pass easily through them.

Mesothelioma: Among the most uncommon types of cancer of the membranes overlying the lungs and chest cavity (pleura), the membranes lining the abdominal cavity (peritoneum), or other membranes surrounding the body's internal organs. Symptoms of Mesothelioma usually appear between 30 and 40 years after asbestos exposure.

Pleural disease: A non-cancerous lung condition that affects the membranes surrounding the lungs and chest cavity (pleura). The membrane can thicken over a wide area (diffuse pleural thickening) or in isolated spots (pleural plaques) or for fluid to accumulate around the lungs (known as pleural effusion).

To avoid these severe health conditions and emotional turmoils associated with these diseases, getting asbestos inspection survey reports in Melbourne before investing in a property is indeed an important step to take.
