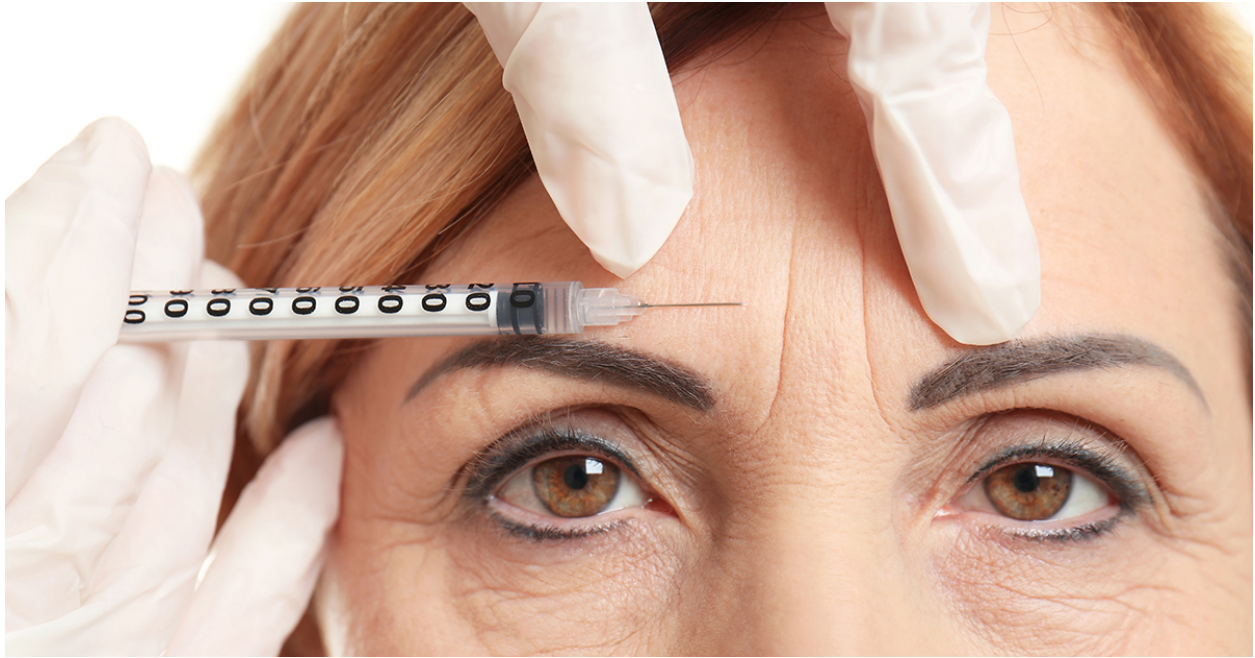


Hyaluronic acid- a potent remedy for wrinkles
