Charcot Marie Tooth

vary patient to patient disease symptoms

weakness of the legs and hands

usually start in the feet. high arched feet

clawed hands

thin calves due to muscle atrophy

numbness in the feet and/or legs

may show in childhood to adulthood high stepage gait and/or "foot slapping" gait

foot drop - difficulty lifting the foot

Demyelination
