

# Charcot Marie Tooth disease symptoms

vary patient to patient



usually start in the feet.

may show in childhood to adulthood

- weakness of the legs and hands
- high arched feet
- clawed hands
- thin calves due to muscle atrophy
- numbness in the feet and/or legs
- high stepage gait and/or "foot slapping" gait
- foot drop - difficulty lifting the foot
